FALLS CITY HAMMER

From the estate of her mother, Doris Strand Iverson, Michele Iverson brought to us this very old hammer, with head stamped: FALLS CITY. With handle, it is about 13 inches long.

Before 1915, the Northern Pacific Depot was called FALLS CITY, but our regional railroad folks say the tools would have been stamped with the railroad name, not the depot name.
