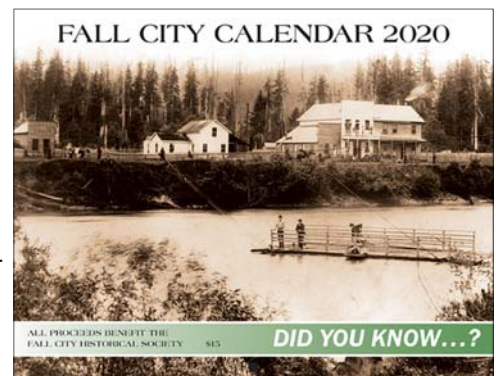


Another successful calendar!
